	Scaffolded/Guided Reading <i>Students with Teacher "We do it together"</i> Coaching and guiding students in their application of strategies
	Independent Reading <i>Student "You do it"</i> Providing students with opportunities to read independently, asking questions, practising strategies, and expressing their responses to the material read
